SC directs states...

The bench opined that hate speech is an offence "affecting the fabric of the nation". As counsels pointed out instances of hate speech in West Bengal and Bihar, Justice Joseph said, "We want to say something. Both of us (judges in the bench) are apolitical. We don't care about party A or party B. We are only on Constitution."

HC orders CBI...

The High Court also directed Collector of every district of the state to ensure compliance of the aforesaid directions. Purohit, would submit the first report in the context of aforesaid facts and circumstances within two weeks from the date of furnishing of the list as aforesaid. One of the petitioners advocate Dilip Sharma said, "Earlier, HC Gwalior bench had ordered CBI probe in a few nursing colleges. Now, the CBI has been asked for probe around 364 nursing colleges."

Govt's aim is...

Even liquor Ahatas have been closed from April 1 on the demand of women in Madhya Pradesh, said Chouhan". He further said the government reduced stamp duty to 1% for registering property in the name of women; otherwise, the duty stands at 3%, said the chief minister, adding that all these measures have been taken for the dignity of women in the state. "Women are not born to be poor and face financial hardships. We have to change their social and financial status. Women should live with dignity. There was gender discrimination in society and so the State government is committed to empower women and provide them equal opportunity. And, this is the reason that many schemes are being run to benefit them right from their birth, providing education, facilitating their marriage and making them self-reliant. There is reservation for women in government jobs. Now, women are not restricted to the kitchen only."

Your honour is...

Later in the evening, the Supreme Court stayed the order passed by Justice Gangopadhyay with the Bench of Justices AS Bopanna and Hima Kohli noting that the order was improper and against judicial discipline. The court directed its Secretary General to convey the top court's order and displeasure to Justice Gangopadhyay. "The order of present nature ought not to have been passed in judicial proceeding keeping in view the judicial discipline. We hereby stay the order passed by the high court judge in the suo motu proceeding," the apex court said. Solicitor General Tushar Mehta who appeared before the bench also agreed that such an order should not have been passed by the high court judge. The Trinamool Congress welcomed the order of the Supreme Court. "The Supreme Court is the apex court of the country and we truly appreciate and accept the verdict given by the Chief Justice of India. We believe that in the coming days, people will get timely justice. I feel there should be a transparent and proper investigation in this matter. If anyone from Trinamool Congress is found guilty, there must be a thorough probe and the guilty should be punished accordingly," Banerjee said.

Hours to lodge...

However, despite the assurance of police action, the wrestlers said they will continue their sit-in protest demanding the "immediate arrest" of the WFI chief. "We respect the Supreme Court's order, but we don't have faith in Delhi Police. This fight is not for an FIR. This fight is to punish people like him. He needs to be in jail and stripped of his portfolios," the wrestlers said. Though the SG told the court earlier in the day that nothing survives in the petition in view of the decision of the Delhi Police to register an FIR, senior advocate Kapil Sibal pressed for directions for safety of the women. "We're worried on two grounds - number one, security and safety. Second, there are 40 cases against the WFI chief. I'll give you the list", Sibal said as he handed over a sealed cover to the court regarding the three perceptions of a minor girl who is an alleged victim of sexual assault. When the SG attempted to oppose the passing of further directions, the CJ snubbed him: "You should support this. They are girls.... We will record your statement that FIR is being registered. Let the girl be provided security. Instead of disposing of it, we will take it after a week on the next Friday." The bench said its direction for providing security to the alleged minor victim shall not stand in the way of the Commissioner of Police making an independent assessment of the threat perception of the other complainants.

'Cheetah deaths within...

It is anticipated that, as observed with cheetah reintroductions in Africa, a few of the founder population may be lost within the first-year post-release," the statement said. J&K BRIBERY CASES

CBI quizzes ex-J&K gov for five hours

NEW DELHI: The CBI questioned former Jammu and Kashmir governor Satya Pal Malik for nearly five hours Friday in connection with its probe into the alleged insurance scam in the Union Territory which came to light after his statement that he was offered bribes to clear related files, officials said. This is the second time that Malik, who served as governor of various states, was quizzed by the CBI. Officials, however, clarified that Malik is not an accused or a suspect in the case so far. His statement was recorded in October last year after he concluded his gubernatorial responsibilities in Bihar, Jammu and Kashmir, Goa, and Meghalaya. After the latest CBI notice to seek clarifications from him, Malik had tweeted, "I have exposed the sins of some people by speaking the truth. Maybe that's why I have been called. I am the son of a farmer, I will not panic. I stand by the truth."

Why Atiq, brother were paraded before media, SC asks UP govt

The Supreme Court on Friday questioned the Uttar Pradesh government why gangster-politician Atiq Ahmad and his brother Ashraf were paraded before media while being taken to hospital for a medical checkup in police custody in Prayagraj.

The top court, which was hearing a plea by advocate Vishal Tiwari seeking an independent probe into the killing of Ahmad and his brother Ashraf, also asked the UP government how the killers got the knowledge that they were being taken to hospital.

"How did they know? We have seen it on TV. Why were they not taken to the ambulance right from the entry gate of the hospital? Why were they paraded?" a bench of Justices S Ravindra Bhat and Dipankar Datta asked senior advocate Mukul Rohatgi,

who appeared for the UP government. Rohatgi informed the bench the state government is probing the incident and has constituted a three-member commission for this. A UP Police special investigation team is also investigating the matter, he said.

"This man and his entire family are embroiled in heinous crimes for last 30 years. This incident particularly is a gruesome incident. We have apprehended the killers and they said they did this to gain importance," Rohatgi said.

Cong leader assaults party worker over saffron kurta

The Amethi district Congress chief has been booked for allegedly abusing and beating up a party worker for donning a saffron kurta to the party office here, police said on Friday.

On the complaint of Akhilesh Shukla, an FIR has been lodged against Congress district unit president Pradeep Singhal, Youth Congress district president Shubham Singh and others for abusing and beating Shukla and issuing

life threats to him, Station House Officer of Amethi Kotwali police station Arun Kumar Dwivedi said.

Shukla, a former vice president of the Amethi Congress unit, said when he visited the party office at Durgapur Road here wearing a saffron kurta and white pants on Thursday evening, party workers accused him of supporting the BJP through his attire instead of campaigning for the Congress for the upcoming municipal elections here, the police officer said.

OPPOSING SAME-SEX MARRIAGE...

Eminent citizens write to Murmu

NEW DELHI: More than 120 eminent citizens, including retired high court judges and former bureaucrats, have written to President Droupadi Murmu opposing what they called "highly objectionable attempts" to legalise same-sex marriages.

They said the Indian society and culture do not accept same-sex behavioural institution as it is irrational and unnatural. The signatories said they were "shocked" over the "continuous onslaught" against the country's basic cultural traditions and religious tenets, in particular, the "highly objectionable attempts" towards legalisation of same-sex union.

The deliberation regarding human institutional relations like that of a marriage is "essentially a legislative function", they said, claiming that the courts should "refrain

from creating or recognising or demolishing the institution of marriage either by way of judicial interpretation or striking down the existing legislative framework for marriages.

The issue is being considered by the constitution bench of the SC and has become a "rallying point" for some "typical pseudo liberals" who are already "divorced" from Indian values under the bogey of "progressive and liberated thinking", they said.

Upset over failing, nine Andhra students commit suicide

Nine students in Andhra Pradesh have ended their lives after failing to clear intermediate examinations.

The results of intermediate first year and second year (Class 11 and 12) were declared on Wednesday.

Nine students have died by suicide in separate incidents since Thursday. Two other students attempted suicide. B. Tarun (17) killed himself by jumping in front of a running train near Tekkali in Srikakulam district. The student of intermediate first year hailing from Dandu Gopalapuram village of the district was disheartened over failure in most of the papers.

A 16-year-old girl hanged herself at a residence at Trinadhapuram under Malkapuram police station limits of Visakhapatnam district. A. Akhilaasree was upset after failing in some subjects of intermediate first year.

B. Jagadeesh (18) ended his life by hanging at his residence at Kancharapalem locality in Visakhapatnam. He had failed in one of the subjects in intermediate second year.

Depressed over failure in one subject in intermediate first year examination, Anusha (17) killed herself by jumping into a lake in Chittoor district.

IED in Dantewada blast planted 2 months ago

RAIPUR: The Chhattisgarh police on Friday said the powerful improvised explosive device (IED) that exploded killing 10 policemen and a civilian driver in Dantewada had been planted by Naxalites at least two months ago.

The explosive, however, remained "undetected" during the demining exercise conducted a day before the

attack on Wednesday, they said.

Ten personnel, belonging to the District Reserve Guard (DRG) of police, and a civilian driver were killed after Naxalites blew up a multi-utility vehicle (MUV), which was part of a convoy carrying security personnel in Arampur police station area of Dantewada on Wednesday after-

Cops foil 'prank' suicide bid

NOIDA: Taking note of a social media post, alert police in Uttar Pradesh's Noida rushed to save a school-boy who posted a "suicide" message only to find that his act was a prank, officials said Friday.

The Gautam Buddha Nagar police commissionerate's social media cell had come across the "suicide video" by a Class 10 student on Instagram and took help from Meta, the parent company of Instagram, to trace the boy's location.

Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police (Central Noida) Rajeev Dixit said the incident took place around 1.30 am on April 26. "The local Phase 2 police station was alerted by Gautam Buddha Nagar police headquarters about a boy putting a suicide video. The Meta headquarters helped in tracing the location of the boy," Dixit said.

"On getting the inputs, the local police immediately reached the spot and found the boy. However, it turned out that the boy, who had posted a video of him consuming the liquid of All Out (mosquito repellent) but in reality he had consumed water which he had filled in an empty All Out vaporizer," the police officer said.
