

DHAKA: A Bangladeshi court on Tuesday sentenced in absentia former top judge Surendra Kumar Sinha, the country's first chief justice from the minority Hindu community, to 11 years in jail on

two counts of graft in a case over money laundering and breach of trust. Dhaka Special Judge 4 Shaikh Nazmul Alam sentenced the former chief justice, who currently lives in US, to 7 years in prison.



Singapore's top court stays execution of Malaysian Indian

Singapore

A 33-year-old Indian-origin Malaysian man's execution was stayed on Tuesday by Singapore's top court after the convicted drug trafficker, believed to be mentally challenged, tested positive for Covid.

News Asia reported. However, he was later abruptly taken away, and a judge informed the court that Nagaenthran had tested positive for Covid.

Justice Andrew Phang, who appeared with fellow judges Judith Prakash and Kannan Ramesh, said, "this is rather unexpected". He said the court was of the view that it was not appropriate to proceed, "given the circumstances".

"The execution is scheduled for tomorrow," said Justice Phang.

"... If the applicant has been afflicted by Covid ... it's our view that the execution cannot take place anyway," the judge said.

The prosecution said they only just heard of the development and needed to take instructions.

"I think here, we have to use logic, common sense and humanity," said Justice Phang.

He adjourned the hearing to a date yet to be fixed and issued a stay of the execution until proceedings are

concluded. Lawyer M Ravi had taken up Nagaenthran's case at the eleventh hour, ahead of his scheduled hanging on Wednesday.

His court application on Monday for a judicial review

of the case on grounds of Nagaenthran's purported mental disability was dismissed, but the judge granted a temporary stay of his execution until after Ravi appealed against the dismissal.

The case was fast-tracked and the appeal set to be heard in the highest court on Tuesday afternoon, with a packed courtroom including foreign media and local activists. Ravi was seen hugging a fellow counsel after the stay of execution was announced, according to a Channel News Asia report.

No other details of when Nagaenthran tested positive for Covid were given, according to the Channel. Nagaenthran was sentenced to death in 2010 for importing 42.72g of heroin into Singapore in 2009 in a bundle strapped to his thigh.

Pak CJ inaugurates rebuilt Hindu temple destroyed by radicals

A century-old Hindu temple, which was vandalised and set on fire by an irate mob of radical Islamists in north-west Pakistan last year, has been opened to devotees by Chief Justice Gulzar Ahmed who had ordered authorities to reconstruct it, according to a media report on Tuesday.

In December last year, century-old Shri Param Hans Ji Maharaj temple in Teri village in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's Karak district was vandalised and demolished by a mob led by some local clerics belonging to the Jamiat Ulema-e-Islam Fazl (JUI-F).

Chief Justice Ahmed at the time ordered authorities to reconstruct the temple and instructed them to recover the money for the restoration work from the attackers whose act had caused "international embarrassment" to Pakistan.

On Monday, Chief Justice

Ahmed attended a grand function at the rebuilt temple to celebrate Diwali festival and to express solidarity with the members of the Hindu community, the Ex-

do so in the future, the paper reported.

He asserted that no one has the authority to destroy or harm a religious place of worship belonging to another community.

The community presented the Chief Justice with a turban and a digital Quran. He was invited to the event by the Pakistan Hindu Council, which also hosted pilgrims from Sindh and Balochistan provinces.

Pakistan Hindu Council patron-in-chief and member of the National Assembly Dr Ramesh Kumar Vankwani expressed gratitude to the measures taken by the Chief Justice and the Supreme Court, the report said.

Kumar, a senior leader of the ruling Tehreek-e-Insaf Party headed by Prime Minister Imran Khan, said that if similar steps are taken to inaugurate four other historic temples, it would help improve the country's image in the world, the report said.

The rebuilt shrine is associated with a saint, Shri Param Hans Ji Maharaj, in Karak district of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province where the temple was established in 1920.

Riot police sent at Poland-Belarus border

Polish riot police reinforced Poland's eastern border on Tuesday, a day after hundreds of migrants tried to storm across the razor-wire border fence from Belarus. Thousands of migrants still remained on the Belarussian side

and Polish authorities feared the tense standoff could escalate.

Polish authorities reported that the situation on the border - which is also the eastern border for the 27-nation European Union and NATO - was calm overnight and Tuesday morning, but after Mon-

day's border scrum they said they were bracing for any possibility.

Poland's Defence Ministry said Tuesday that a large group of Belarussian forces was moving toward the migrants, who were camping out on the border.

Major Katarzyna Zdanowicz, from the re-

gion's border guards, estimated 3,000-4,000 migrants were along the border, including about 800 in the vicinity of the large makeshift migrant camp. She also said there was a greater concentration of Belarussian services on the border to "control, steer and direct these people."

Palestinians too victims of Pegasus

International hacking experts say Palestinians belonging to rights organizations that Israel outlawed had been targeted by spyware made by the Israeli tech firm NSO Group, The New York Times reported.

It raised questions about whether the Israeli government was behind the hack-

ing, a claim that officials there denied.

NSO, which was recently blacklisted by the US, has been criticized for years for selling its spyware programme, Pegasus, to clients that include authoritarian governments.

Pegasus allows users to remotely monitor a phone's location and extract contents.

भोपाल, (निप्र)। मध्यप्रदेश के सबसे बड़े सरकारी अस्पताल हमीदिया अस्पताल में सोमवार रात को हुए भीषण अग्निकांड के दूसरे दिन भी अफरा-तफरी का माहौल बना हुआ है। एसएनसीयू वार्ड में भर्ती करीब 7 बच्चों की मौत अब तक हो चुकी है। हालांकि सरकार ने 4 बच्चों की ही मौत की पुष्टि की है। कई परिजन अब भी बच्चा नहीं मिलने या बच्चा बदल जाने की शिकायत कर रहे हैं। पूर्व मुख्यमंत्री कमलनाथ के साथ पूर्व मंत्री पीसी शर्मा और भोपाल जिला कांग्रेस अध्यक्ष कैलाश मिश्रा भी साथ थे। कमलनाथ ने कर्मला नेहरू अस्पताल परिसर पहुंचकर शिशु वार्ड में आग लगने की घटना के बाद की स्थिति का जायजा लिया। कमलनाथ ने पीड़ित परिवारों से भी मुलाकात की। उन्होंने चिकित्सकों से बच्चे के इलाज के संबंध में भी चर्चा की। कमलनाथ ने आरोप लगाया कि यहां आंकड़े छिपाने का खेल चल रहा है। उन्होंने स्वास्थ्य मंत्री के बंगले का घेराव करने की बात भी कही। कमलनाथ ने कहा कि इस मामले की जांच सिरिटिंग जज से कराना चाहिए। पिछले 6 माह में यह दूसरी घटना है। विभागीय मंत्री को जिम्मेदारी लेते हुए इस्तीफा देना चाहिए।

गोपाल, (निप्र)। गोपाल के हमीदिया अस्पताल के शिशु वार्ड में जो आग लगी। उसमें तीन बच्चों ने आँसू भी नहीं छोले। वे। वह आग से जलकर काल कालित हो गये। यह अत्यंत दुर्भाग्यपूर्ण एवं दुःखद घटना है। डॉ. अर्चना जायसवाल अध्यक्ष मण्डल कांग्रेस ने बताया हमीदिया अस्पताल के अन्दर जाने नहीं दिया गया। अस्पताल के बाहर बच्चों के परिजन बदबवास हालत में घूम रहे हैं। बिलख रहे हैं और अपने बच्चों को ढूँढ रहे हैं। डॉ. जायसवाल ने कहा पूर्व में भी ऐसी घटना अस्पताल में कई बार हो चुकी है परन्तु मात्रा का शासन, प्रशासन और अस्पताल प्रबंधन अंध नुक़र बने हैं। आज की घटना दिल दहला देने वाली है। वे मांग करती हैं कि दोषियों के खिलाफ कड़ी से कड़ी कार्रवाई हो, स्वास्थ्य मंत्री, इस्तीफा दें बच्चों के परिजनों के इस अख़्त दुःख की चड़ी में हल उनके साथ है।

हमीदिया अग्निकांड, उमा भारती ने उठाए फायर सेफ्टी पर सवाल

कहा- अपराधियों पर कार्रवाई से होगा राजधर्म का पालन

भोपाल, (निप्र)। हमीदिया हॉस्पिटल में आग लगने के मामले में मध्यप्रदेश की पूर्व मुख्यमंत्री और भाजपा नेत्री उमा भारती ने व्यवस्था पर सवाल उठाए हैं। उन्होंने सोशल मीडिया पर हादसे पर दुःख प्रकट किया। साथ ही कहा कि मृतक शिशुओं के माता-पिता एवं परिवार के प्रति मेरी अत्यधिक संवेदना है। यद्यपि उनके दुःखों की भरपाई नहीं हो सकती, परंतु अपराधियों के खिलाफ कठोरतम कार्रवाई से राजधर्म पालन होगा।

उमा भारती ने सोशल मीडिया पर लिखा कि भोपाल के हमीदिया हॉस्पिटल के अंतर्गत कर्मला नेहरू अस्पताल के नवजात शिशु वार्ड में हुए हादसे में नवजात शिशुओं की दर्दनाक मौत हुई है। इसे भुलाया नहीं जा सकता। इस हादसे ने अनेक सवाल खड़े कर दिए हैं। इसमें जिन्होंने भी लापरवाही की है, उन्हें अतिशीघ्र कठोरतम दंड मिलना चाहिए। मध्यप्रदेश के मुख्यमंत्री शिवराज सिंह चौहान से बात हुई है। वे भी इस घटना से बहुत दुःखी हैं। उन्होंने सवाल किया कि कर्मला नेहरू

अस्पताल के नवजात शिशु वार्ड का फायर ऑउट कब से नहीं हुआ? उसके मटेनेंस और मॉनिटरिंग की जिम्मेदारी किसकी थी? इसे कब और कितना बजट मिला है? सारे तथ्यों की जांच कर अपराधियों को चुरंत कठोरतम दंड मिलना चाहिए।

उच्चस्तरीय जांच के आदेश

भोपाल के हमीदिया हॉस्पिटल परिसर में स्थित कर्मला नेहरू गैस राहत हॉस्पिटल में सोमवार रात करीब 9 बजे आग लगी थी। अस्पताल की तीसरी मंजिल पर बच्चा वार्ड के एसएनसीयू में 40 बच्चे भर्ती थे, जहां आग से सबसे अधिक नुक़सान हुआ है। हादसा शॉर्ट सर्किट की वजह से होने की बात कही जा रही है। मुख्यमंत्री ने उच्चस्तरीय जांच के निर्देश दिए हैं। सूत्रों का कहना है कि पोस्टमार्टम के लिए 7 बच्चों के शव लाए गए हैं। हालांकि, सरकारी आंकड़ों के मुताबिक चार बच्चों की मौत हुई है। एक दर्जन से अधिक नवजात शिशुस गए हैं।

हमीदिया मैनेजमेंट की लापरवाही नोटिस और चेतावनी के बाद भी नहीं सुधारा फायर सिस्टम

गोपाल, (निप्र)। कर्मला नेहरू चिकित्सालय में सोमवार की रात हुई आगजनी में हमीदिया अस्पताल मैनेजमेंट की बड़ी लापरवाही सामने आई है। नगर निगम का फायर ब्रिगेड विभाग के लगातार नोटिस के बाद भी मैनेजमेंट ने फायर सिस्टम सुधारने की जरूरत तक नहीं समझी। पिछले एक साल में करीब 4 से 5 बार नोटिस जारी किए गए, लेकिन मैनेजमेंट ने ध्यान नहीं दिया। अखिरी बार 22 जून को अस्पताल प्रबंधन को उनके फायर सिस्टम की खामी सुधारने के लिए नोटिस जारी किया गया था।

इस नोटिस को भी 147 दिन बीत चुके हैं। 8 नवंबर तक अस्पताल प्रबंधन ने सुधार नहीं किया। न ही फायर सिस्टम को अपडेट किया ना फायर पांच नोटिस जारी किए जा चुके हैं। इसके बाद भी डिपार्टमेंट की तरफ से लगातार भेजे गए नोटिस और खामियों को सुधारने को लेकर वे नजर अंदाज करते रहे। सुधार के लिए कहा गया था। यह भी चेताया गया था कि कभी कोई आगजनी घटना हुई, तो कैसे निपटेंगे। बहुत सारी गफ़लत मिली थी, लेकिन अस्पताल प्रबंधन की तरफ से नहीं सुधार नहीं किया गया। 22 जून के पहले 12 अप्रैल को भी फायर सिस्टम की खामियों और उसे सुधार के लिए नोटिस जारी किया गया था। 12 अप्रैल को वे फायर विभाग की ओर से कर्मला नेहरू अस्पताल को जारी किया गया था। नगर निगम में फायर विभाग के प्रभारी अपर आयुक्त केएस परिहार ने बताया कि पिछले एक डेढ़ साल में कर्मला नेहरू चिकित्सालय को चार-पांच नोटिस जारी किए जा चुके हैं। इसके बाद भी डिपार्टमेंट की तरफ से लगातार भेजे गए नोटिस और खामियों को सुधारने को लेकर वे नजर अंदाज करते रहे।

भोपाल, (निप्र)। भोपाल पुलिस ने सोमवार रात को गल्ला मंडी के सामने हुई हत्या के आरोपियों को गिरफ्तार कर लिया है। आरोपियों में तीन नाबालिग भी शामिल हैं। मामला छोला थाना क्षेत्र का है। सोमवार रात करीब नौ बजे चंदू पंथी निवासी प्रेमनगर, का आलोक कुचवर्दिया और दो नाबालिगों से विवाद हो गया था। विवाद होने के बाद चंदू पंथी वहीं खड़ा था, जबकि आलोक साधियों को बुला लाया था। वह साथ में छुरी लेकर आए थे। विवाद बढ़ा तो नाबालिगों ने चंदू को पकड़ा और आलोक के साथ-साथ शानू कुचवर्दिया ने उस पर छुरी से कई बार वार किए। इससे चंदू की मौके पर मौत हो गई और आरोपी फरार हो गए। चंदू के भाई विक्की की शिकायत पर छोला थाने में केस दर्ज हुआ था। पुलिस ने आलोक को विदिशा से और शानू को भानपुर चैराहे के पास रेलवे पटरी से गिरफ्तार किया है। तीनों नाबालिगों को भी हिरासत में लेकर हथियार बरामद किए गए। थाना प्रभारी अनिल सिंह मौर्य ने बताया कि शानू कुचवर्दिया, उम्र 30 साल और आलोक कुचवर्दिया उम्र 19 साल को के साथ-साथ तीनों नाबालिग अपराधियों को गिरफ्तार कर लिया गया है।

Sops for power

Two new Tehsil Killod and Mundi will be carved out in Khandwa district, Digoda in Tikamgarh district and Dhoolkot Tehsil in Burhanpur district. State Cabinet also approved proposal to change name of newly-formed Chhindwara University to Raja Shankar Shah University. CM Chouhan had made an announcement regarding this on September 18 in Jabalpur. Cabinet also approved the proposal to open 11 new government colleges and to start science and commerce faculty in five existing colleges. Moreover, sanction for 233 academic and 228 non-academic posts were also approved. Cabinet approved 138 new posts for TN Hospital in Bhopal that would be up-graded to Regional Institute for Respiratory Diseases.

CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE

This was unfortunate incident and (outcome of) a criminal negligence. The Additional chief secretary Health and Medical Education will investigate the incident and strict action will be taken against the guilty, he added. Praising the hard work of minister for Medical Education Vishwas Sarang, who immediately rushed to the hospital on getting information about the fire, the CM said who put their lives at risk to rescue the children deserve appreciation. Such doctors, nurses, ward boys etc would be honoured. The CM said Sarang reached the spot as soon as he got the information about the incident and immediately co-ordinated the relief work. The CM also thanked the police administration and the team of doctors for taking prompt action and saving the lives of children. He further said, "I had a desire to reach the spot immediately. I constantly remained in touch with Sarang. I was told that my going there may divert the attention of the people engaged in the relief work. The focus of the teams should be on evacuation of children safely."

Hospital ignored BMC...

There was yet another notice dated June 22, 2021 by the additional commissioner, BMC to all the hospitals in Bhopal to get the NoC regarding compliance of the fire safety norms.

The BMC also warned that if the hospitals didn't comply with the notice within a month a recommendation would be made to get their licences cancelled. Public health expert Amulya Nidhi says the government's admission that the fire incident took place due to a short circuit at Kamala Nehru suggests that had the hospital chosen to comply with the fire safety norms to get the NoC the fatal incident could have been averted and several lives could have been saved. Amulya Nidhi said BMC was equally responsible for the incident as it slept over its own notices and didn't take follow-up action.

Despite efforts the BMC commissioner and the hospital authorities couldn't be reached for their comments. JUDICIAL INQUIRY: Meanwhile, leader Opposition in the state assembly and state Congress president Kamal Nath dubbed the inquiry by ACS, Health Mohd Suleman as an eyewitness aimed at, he alleged, covering up the flaws in the system and shield those responsible for the incident. Nath demanded a judicial inquiry instead, that too with a sitting judge of high court.

Two minor girls...

Sunil Barkare, SDO of Begumganj in Raisen district, said the 12-year-old victim had returned early from school and was alone at home when the minor boy, aged 17, entered her house and committed the crime, he said. When the girl's neighbour, aged 28, saw the incident, he also raped her, the police officer said. The 28-year-old accused was arrested on Monday, while the minor boy is absconding, he said. In Khandwa district, three persons abducted and raped the 15-year-old girl when she was sleeping at her relative's home on Saturday night at a village, Harsud Police Station in-charge Ishwar Singh Chouhan said. After finding that the girl was missing, family members launched a search and found her in injured near the home, he said. Later, the girl narrated her ordeal to her family members, who subsequently filed a police complaint, Chouhan said. Chouhan further said one of the three accused has been arrested. In both the cases, the accused have been booked under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO Act).

1.6 YEAR OLD...

They said that rain water would enter their house and fields through the pipe. Because of the conflict, some villagers sat on the road. After that, police force was summoned to remove the agitating villagers. According to the villagers, the police began lathi charge and it hit the child, due to which she died. At the same time, the villagers also pelted stones and SI Raghavendra Yadav received injuries. On getting the information, SP Rajesh Singh Chandel, Collector Akshay Kumar Singh and Karaira MLA Pragilal Jatav reached the spot. According to the MLA, he has spoken to the villagers to pacify the situation. A large number of police forces have, however, reached the spot after the dispute.

Can courts override...

"Can the highest constitutional court say that we will override the defence needs, particularly in view of the recent past? Can we say that environment concerns will triumph over the defence needs of the nation?" it asked, adding, "Is it appropriate to say that defence concerns be taken care of so that environmental degradation does not take place?"

The bench told senior advocate Colin Gonsalves, representing the petitioners: "We must tell you our predicament in this. If the Centre says that they are doing it for tourism, then we understand and we can impose more stringent conditions." But when it is needed to defend the borders, then it is a serious predicament, Justice Chandrachud said.

Gonsalves cited the catastrophic impact of road expansion on young mountains like the Himalayas and added that parliamentary expert committee reports suggest Himalayas may not be able to bear the road construction. The AG argued that there are several projects leading to international borders, which are needed for Army movements and the Army was ignored in this matter, however now its needs must be brought on record. The top court was hearing a plea filed by NGO 'Citizens for Green Doon' seeking direction to stop felling of trees without clearances on the Ganeshpur-Dehradun Road (NH-72A), which is a part of the Delhi-Dehradun expressway. The hearing in the matter will continue on Wednesday. In 2018, the Centre's notification said that the road width cannot exceed 5.5 metres in the hilly terrains like the one through which Chardham project is proposed. In September 2020, the top court directed the government to keep the width of the Chardham road at 5.5 metres. However, in December 2020, this notification was amended. The Chardham highway is a 900-kilometre road project to provide all-weather connectivity to four Hindu pilgrimage centres in Uttarakhand.

Driver of car whose passenger asked for Antilia traced

MUMBAI Mumbai police have traced the driver of a car whose passenger had asked a cab-like about the location of industrialist Mukesh Ambani's residence 'Antilia' here, an official said on Tuesday.

The driver of that car, a private cab, was brought to the Azad Maidan police station here for questioning after the vehicle were traced to neighbouring Navi Mumbai late Monday night, the official said.

Security was beefed up on Monday outside industrialist Ambani's residence after a taxi driver informed the police that two suspected passengers in a vehicle carrying bags with them had asked him about the location of 'Antilia', a 27-storey building located on Altamout Road in south Mumbai.

Reeling under rain havoc, TN braces for more

CHENNAI Even as it is reeling under the impact of rain fury, Tamil Nadu is bracing for more trouble with the Met Department predicting further rain over the next five days.

The state government has put the death toll so far; due to rains, at five.

State Revenue and Disaster Management Minister K.K.S.S.R. Ramachandran said that water is being pumped out of low-lying areas after lull in rainfall on Tuesday. He said that rescue operations are underway by the NDRF, army, and Fire Department personnel.

Across the state, educational institutions in 14 districts have had to suspend classes due to the continued rainfall. A depression is expected

Dam feud: Kerala loses more ground

Kerala is getting into an increasingly untenable situation with regard to the Mullaperiyar dam, with pressures from possibly all directions working against the interest of the state. The latest development in a continuing muddle is a recommendation from the central government to do everything that Tamil Nadu has been demanding by way of helping in the strengthening of the baby dam.

The central water resources secretary has sent a letter to the Kerala chief secretary, asking the state to cooperate in strengthening the baby dam as well for maintenance of the main dam.

This will facilitate Tamil Nadu to raise the water level in the main dam to 142 feet, which the people living in the downstream areas of the dam consider as life-threatening. Meanwhile, the

Pinarayi Vijayan government has been tying itself in knots, trying to run away from the responsibility of granting permission to cut 15 trees in the baby dam catchment, which happens to be part of the Periyar tiger reserve.

Forest minister AK Saseendran has been caught in a predicament, in which he has had to deny any knowledge of the tree cutting plan, even as it emerged that the decision was taken after much deliberations at the highest level, including a joint inspection of the area and identification of the trees to be cut by a team comprising the representatives of both the states.

The government plan to extricate itself from the tricky situation by taking action against the chief forest conservator and wild life warden has run into a roadblock as it has become clear they were only acting on the decisions arrived at by the joint consultations between the states.

Amid an uproar both within the state assembly and outside that the Vijayan government has failed to protect the interests of the state, the government had frozen the permission to cut the trees.

But the disclosure of joint consultations at the official level has held back the govt, which has since decided to refer the matter to the advocate general for legal opinion. It turns out the original pact between the states for the construction and upkeep of the 126-year old dam had provided for cutting of trees in the catchment area if that was warranted for the upkeep of the structures.

Sentiments on are getting charged up on both sides of the border, with AIADMK and BJP staging protests to pressure the Stalin govt to increase the water level in the dam to 142 ft, for which the Tamil Nadu govt already enjoys a mandate from the court.

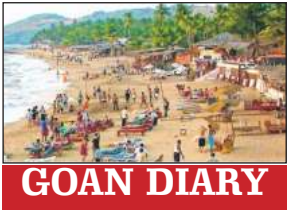
Goa falls to 2nd spot in governance index amongst small states

As far as equity is concerned in the Small States category Sikkim ranks 1st, followed by Meghalaya ranking 2nd and Mizoram ranking 3rd. Similarly, Uttarakhand ranks 9th, Delhi 10th and Arunachal 11th.

As per Growth parameter in the Small States category Goa ranks 1st, followed by Delhi and Himachal. Performing last are Meghalaya, Nagaland and Manipur.

In sustainability category the small states placed at the top are Mizoram, Arunachal and Goa ranking 1st, 2nd and 3rd respectively.

Rape, murder victims' age insufficient for death penalty: SC

NEW DELHI: Low age of victims in rape-and-murder cases has not been considered as the "only or sufficient factor by this court" for imposing the death penalty, the Supreme Court has said referring to its verdict that had analysed 67 similar cases dealt by it in the last 40 years. The sc's crucial observation came on an appeal of Irappa Siddappa who was convicted and given the death penalty by a trial court. The Karnataka High Court confirmed the trial court's decision on March 6, 2017.

He was convicted for kidnapping, rape and murder of a five-year-old-girl in the village of Khanapur in Karnataka in 2010 and post the incident, he had put the body of the victim in a bag and thrown it into a stream, named Benihalla. A bench comprising Justices L Nageswara Rao, Sanjiv Khanna and BR Gavai confirmed the conviction of Siddappa for offences including rape, murder and destruction of evidence, but set aside the award of death penalty, which was handed down by courts below on grounds including the minor age of the victim, and commuted it to life imprisonment for a period of 30 years.

"We find sufficient mitigating factors to commute the sentence of death imposed by the Sessions Court and confirmed by the High Court into imprisonment for life, with the direction that the appellant shall not be entitled to premature release/remission for the offence under Section 302 (murder) of the Code until he has undergone actual imprisonment for at least thirty years," said the verdict penned by Justice Khanna for the bench.
